Use whatever means possible: plugins, hosting backups, local backups, etc.



Create a new test site on a testing url.

Something like https://test.mysite.com

Clone your live website to this new test url using the backup you just created.



Install the free "Disable Emails" WordPress plugin on the test site.

https://wordpress.org/plugins/disable-emails/

Disable Stripe plugins,
WooCommerce, and all other payment plugins on the test site.

Update all plugins & WordPress core software on the test site.



Confirm everything works properly on the test site.

Check links, menus, e-commerce, shopping carts, forms, landing pages, etc.

Fix any bugs that the upgrade created on the test site.



Perform the plugin & WordPress core software updates on the live site.



Confirm everything works properly on the live site.

Check links, menus, e-commerce, shopping carts, forms, payment methods, etc.
